- reinforce on work ethics
- learn how to lead, plan and operate
- student development theory SPICE
- paid positions
- supervised by co-curricular specialist and student life staff
- increase tools and skills for problem solving
- professional conduct and approach strategies
- additional responsibilities such as monthly theme holiday event, weekend activities logistics, intramural programs, movie night events
- involved with hiring procedures of student assistants
- enhance time management
- weekly schedule changes so student assistants are to meet weekly to determine shifts (10 hours per week from Sunday to Saturday paid by state minimum wage)
- student employee agreement contract
- staff must come at opening and closing of the eagle zone for accountability
- paraprofessional = abide by the student code of conduct
